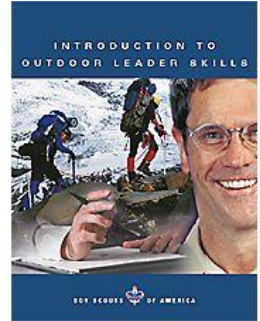


Tomahawk District IOLS Training 2010

What to bring: Each adult is responsible for his own personal camping equipment listed below.
Troop /patrol equipment will be provided.

- Official Scout uniform¹
- Underwear and socks
- Shoes or boots²
- Scout t-shirt for activities
- Any personal drinks (we supply water)
- Windbreaker or jacket
- Rain gear
- Sleepwear
- Toiletries (including soap, shampoo, etc)
- Towel & washcloth
- Flashlight with spare batteries/bulb
- Mess kit, including cup or mug (plastic or metal, no glass), plate or bowl and utensils
- Pocketknife or multi-tool (no fixed-blade knives)
- Personal medication in labeled containers
- Pen or pencil for note-taking and paper
- Boy Scout Handbook
- Water bottle (1 quart)
- Backpack (or duffle bag)
- Sleeping bag and pillow
- Tent (may share with other adult)
- Folding camp chair (no loungers)
